No. LA/CB/S/ML-Silica Sand (50)/18/328 : Being the competent authority in his capacity as the Licencing Authority—made by the Government of Sindh through an amendment to Rule 2 (z) of the Sindh Mining Concession Rules, 2002 ("the Rules") at the Cabinet meeting held on 19th February 2018, notified in the Sindh Government Gazette Number M-324, published on 22nd March 2018—and pursuant to **para 22 of the order dated 12th December 2018, passed by the High Court of Sindh, Bench at Sukkur, in CP No. 3602 of 2016, filed by M/s Rohri Cement Factory Limited**, the undersigned is pleased to **suspend** the mining lease for silica sand over an area of 443.0 acres at / near **Rohri, District Sukkur**, renewed on 15.12.2017 for 20 years up to 24th July 2022 (without the ownership of land) to **M/s. Associated Cement Rohri Limited, Rohri**, as per the annexed map/drawing, *vide* Notification No. DMD/S/ML-Silica Sand (50)/17/1299 dated 15.12.2017.



- ✓ 1. **M/s. Associated Cement Rohri Limited, Rohri** They are informed that the competent authority, stated as above, has suspended the mining lease as mentioned in the notification above. So, they are required to stop the mining operations in the area, remove all **their** machinery, *etc.*, if any, from the site, and hand the area over to the concerned officer of this Department within one month to be spared from the departmental action under the Rules.
2. The Deputy Commissioner, District **Sukkur**.
3. The Deputy Director, Mineral Development, **Sukkur**. He is directed to take all appropriate measures to stop the mining operations on site of the expired concession, remove the machinery, *etc.*, if any, from the site, and take over the possession of the area from the holder of the **suspended** mining concession, along with other necessary actions under the Rules (such as Rule 106) and other laws of the land and the government policies, relevant to the case, in due course of time.

He is requested to issue the necessary directives to the concerned police officers/officials for taking further necessary action to get the mining operations in the **suspended** mining concession area immediately stopped and reported to this Department.

He is required to take immediately the further necessary action to stop the mining operations by the party in the area under reference, as the mining permit in question has been **suspended** by the competent authority (*i.e.*, the Licencing Authority, referred to above).
